Troy Lions Club Homecoming Stand Rules for 2017

July 20th, 21st and 22nd 2017 Lions Homecoming stand rules and prices:

2017 Troy Lions Club Homecoming will build on the success we enjoyed in 2016. Our entertainment and amusement rides will be located as they were in 2016. Food and grass roots stands will still be located on Wickliffe. To make sure your group is accommodated, it is critically important that you work with John Myers about the best placement for your stand(s).

Troy Community Band, followed by Living Loud will be our featured entertainment on Friday night. The Shriners Band and Well Hungarians will return to the stage on Saturday night. Premier Works will be back with their amusement rides. Watch for more information as plans are finalized.

Thursday night is **Family Night** and features our Children's Parade at 6:30 p.m., discounted amusement rides from 5 to 9, Big Papa G on stage and Character entertainment immediately following the parade. Food and non-alcoholic beverages bill be available. Set up must be completed by 5:00 p.m. as the street will close from 5:00 through 9:00 p.m., without exception. Stands may open at 5:00 p.m. The Children's Parade will begin at 6:30 p.m. and the Carnival will close at 9:00.

Friday and Saturday are normal Homecoming nights. There will be Parades, music and the carnival on Friday and Saturday. Set up must be completed by 5:00 p.m. as the street will close from 5:00 through 12:00 p.m., without exception. Stands open at 5:00 p.m. The Parade will begin at 6:30 p.m. on Friday night and 6:30 p.m. on Saturday night.

A "Stand" is defined as a 15 foot street frontage by 10 feet deep. Your space is assigned for all three days. You may open for all three nights or for Friday and Saturday, but the space charges are the same.

Not for profit organizations <u>not</u> selling <u>main menu</u> food will be charged **\$60** for a single space and **\$40** for an additional space. Snack or desert items **are allowed** to be sold by these organizations at this rental price.

Not for profit organizations selling <u>main menu</u> food will be charged **\$150** for a single space and **\$100** for an additional space.

Commercial stands <u>not</u> selling <u>main menu</u> food will be charged **\$150** for each space.

Commercial stands selling <u>main course menu</u> food (such as meat and potatoes etc.) will be priced at **\$250** for a single space and **\$175** for an additional space. These food items must not be the same as the Lions Club is serving (see below).

There will be a \$50 deposit required for each organization renting booth space to be returned after satisfactory clean up at the end of the event. Clean up to be completed before leaving Saturday night.

You will not be allowed to sell same items that the Lions Club is serving.

The Lions Club will be serving Fish, Burgers, Brats, Hot Dogs, Corn Dogs, Corn-onthe-Cob, Chicken Strips and Fries plus Beer, Soda.

Venders selling food or drink will need a permit from Madison County Health Dept. There is a permit fee. The permit costs more on the day of event!! Health Dept Phone <u>618-692-8954</u>. Permit should be completed 2 weeks prior to the event. <u>www.madisoncountyhealthdepartment.org</u> Refunds will not be granted for your failure to secure a Health Dept. Permit or failing the Inspection.

The Grass Roots Stand form includes a "Referred By" line. If you know of a vendor or a group, that did not have a stand at the 2015 Troy Homecoming, tell them what a great event it is, and encourage them to be a part of it. When they decide to join us, have them put your name (the same name you used to reserve your 2016 Homecoming Stand) on the "Referred By" line. When they send in their non-refundable stand fee, you have earned 25% of their stand fee – regardless of the type of stand they have. At the conclusion of the Homecoming, we will send you a check for all the rebates you have earned from your referrals.
