UMPIRE JOB DESCRIPTION

Baseball/Softball Umpires report to the UIC.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- Attend all necessary umpire meetings.
- Demonstrate the ability to officiate baseball/softball showing sufficient knowledge of rules and mechanics.
- Abide by all of the Tri-Township Park District's baseball/softball league bylaws, code of conduct, rules, regulations and procedures, including the inclement weather policy.
- The umpire will be ready to work fifteen (15) minutes prior to the scheduled game time. Games are scheduled Monday-Thursday evenings and Saturday mornings.
- The umpire may officiate baseball and/or girls softball games.
- The umpire will remain unbiased while umpiring games and will avoid verbal contact with spectators.
- The umpire will approach his/her position as a representative of the Tri-Township Park District by displaying respect for the facility, participants, parents and co-workers.
- Keep track of game time.

SPECIFIC INFORMATION

Umpires will be paid \$20 per game.

You will need to apply and turn in all required paperwork before this date. If you cannot attend training on the set date, you will need to let us know immediately to determine if there is another solution.

Games begin May 1st and will run through the third week of July. Games are Monday-Thursday evenings (5:20PM arrival) and Saturday mornings (8:20AM arrival).
