

Tri-Township Park District
Feb. 5 1973. 111

A special meeting of the Board of Commissioners of The Tri-Township Park District was held Monday Evening Feb. 5 1973 at Russ's car wash.

Commissioners present were Russell Wiesemeyer, Oscar Sindler, Milton Langenwaller, George Schmalz, and J. W. Dull.

Others present were: Paul Riebold & Bill Thompson.

President Wiesemeyer called the meeting to order at 8:00 P.M.

Paul Riebold discussed the anticipated income for Jarvis Township from the State ~~revenue~~ revenue sharing plan. If the plan is carried out for the 5 years now planned, the Township would have approximately \$48,000⁰⁰ above allowable expenses that could be paid out of the funds. It is thought that the Township could use this money to re-juvinate the old house at the Park for a library, reading rooms, meeting rooms and recreation rooms. It was thought that the money could not be used to provide living quarters for a care-taker of the park.

Wiesemeyer is going to see Mr. Thompson about getting a quick estimate of the work for the benefit of the town auditors, and perhaps later draw up plans and specifications for rebuilding the house, split up in such a manner that the work could be contracted for in piece-meal jobs, in case the revenue sharing plan should be discontinued before the end of the 5 year period.

The meeting adjourned at 10:00 P.M.
