

A Special meeting of the Board of Commissioners was held Wednesday Evening, March 14, 1973 at Russ's Car Wash.

Commissioners present were: Russell Wiesemeyer, Oscar Gindler, Milton Langenwatter, George Schmalz, and J. W. Dull.

Others Present were: Bill Thompson, and Albert Arth.

The meeting was called to order by President Wiesemeyer at 8:00 P.M.

It was moved by Oscar Gindler and seconded by J. W. Dull that we pay the Election Judges \$20<sup>00</sup> each, same as was paid last year. The motion carried.

Mr Thompson showed slides of different steel buildings and discussed the advantages and dis-advantages of steel buildings. He discussed in particular the Strand steel building at the church north of Hamel and a new ~~school~~ <sup>church</sup> building being constructed in North St. Louis, with provisions for future expansion.

A modern steel building finished, but without equipment will cost about \$15<sup>00</sup> per square foot.

The discussion was in connection <sup>with the idea</sup> of building a community building at the Park with possible revenue sharing funds from the Townships. In which case the old house would later be removed, as recommended by Mr. Thompson.

The meeting was adjourned at 10:15 P.M.
