

The regular monthly meeting of the New Township Park District Board of Commissioners was convened at the pavillion on May 21, 1985 with president Russell Wisemeyer presiding. Commissioners present in addition to the president were Touck and Jarman.

The minutes of the previous meeting were read & approved.

Com Wisemeyer reported that Cooper Asphalt had prepared a bid for repair of the blacktop in two places in front of the pavillion & cracks in the tennis court but the bid has not been received. Milton Parkerson has agreed to repair the gables on the pavillion when he can work the job into his schedule.

The Board was informed that a letter had been sent to Mr. Meyer requesting that the new park property be planted with soybeans & properly weeded.

The budget has been posted for public review. Com Wisemeyer discussed applying for matching funds for the improvement of the new park property. Motion was made by Com Touck to hire architect Bill Thompson to prepare the necessary paperwork to apply to the Dept. of Conservation for a matching or 40% grant for the purpose of rehabilitation of the 7+ acres & for playground equipment. Motion was seconded by Com Jarman & carried. Com Wisemeyer will follow thru.

Dan Rolling has vacated the trailer. Com Jarman spoke with Mr. Pundleton about taking possession of the trailer. Mr. Pundleton has a physical impairment which will not permit him to do any heavy work.

Com. Messinger suggested that the Mayor be asked to advise on action regarding the street work in front of the park.
