Park Board Meeting Minutes

December 13th, 7 PM

Meeting was called to order at 7:00 PM and the Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Roll Call: Bud Adelhardt, Steve Barbour, Toby Mitchell, James Newcombe, Dave Nonn George Vogt, and Kevin Woodring.

Executive Committee:

Operations Committee:

Spin City: Bennie Parr reports that the busy season has begun. Bennie has delivered over 10,000 flyers to schools that include discount passes for the holiday season to help increase business. Skate with Santa will be on December 16th from 2 to 5. Commissioner Nonn asks how weather affects business at Spin City and if Bennie is prepared for the busy time of year.

Roads and Grounds: Commissioner Nonn reports that all vendors check have cleared the bank and grant paperwork will be turned in soon.

Athletic Committee: Commissioner Newcombe reports that the recreational sports season is done, and Ann is getting ready for Baseball/softball season. Athletic Committee held a meeting on the 13th to line everything out for baseball/softball season. Concession stand 4 does not make money, Ann is looking at vending machines and talked to a company that is willing to do all of the work and give the park 30% of the sales.
